FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: What are the dues for the year and what are cleanup days?

A: The dues for the year are \$450.00 for couples and families, \$350.00 for single persons, \$250.00 for tennis only memberships. In addition, there are Spring and Fall maintenance/cleanup fees if members prefer not to participate in 2 cleanup days per year. Two weekends are reserved for members who want to work rather than pay their cleanup fees. The requirement is 2 hours for single persons, 3 hours for couples and families. The fee in lieu of working are \$50 each for spring and fall. Other arrangements for work contributions can be discussed if you are not available on the cleanup days.

Q: The hours the pool is open with lifeguards is inconvenient for me and/or my family. Is there any way I can go early in the morning or later at night?

A: Yes, but there are requirements. **FIRST**, you must sign a family waiver absolving the club of any liability during unguarded hours. **SECOND**, you must not use the diving boards when there is no certified lifeguard on duty-this is an insurance requirement and any violation could cause us to close the pool. **THIRD**, no pets are allowed in the pool area at any time. **FOURTH**, there is no solo swimming – this is a commonsense requirement for your safety. After signing the waiver and delivering it to the President (Jimmy Tate), you will get a combination to a lock that is on the gate to the left of the main entrance of the pool. **MAKE SURE TO LOCK THE GATE BEHIND YOU WHEN ENTERING AND WHEN YOU LEAVE.**

Q: I have guests visiting from out of town. Can they use the pool?

A: The Embry Hills Club has always had a generous guest policy. You may have an unlimited number of guests use the pool as long as they are not in our neighborhood. We need to have our neighbors join and support the pool! We are flexible to a certain extent, but please realize that it takes a lot of members to keep our club running. Guest may only visit the pool during lifeguarded hours. The Family Waiver does not cover guests.

Q: What if I want to have a social function (birthday party, etc.) at the club?

A: For members, use of the club facilities for parties are free. All we require is that you reserve the day and time you wish to have your event. If you are expecting a large number of your guests to use the pool, you may be required to hire an extra (certified) lifeguard for your party. If your event is after the pool's normally guarded hours and you are expecting to use the pool, you must arrange for your own lifeguards. Of course, you are expected to clean up after your event and leave the clubhouse and grounds as you found them. Members who live outside of the Embry Hills area must be members for a year before reserving the clubhouse.
